

To Photographer or Videographer

We welcome you to St. Joseph's and hope we can work together to provide a wonderful celebration for our couples and their family and friends as well as a record of their fond memories.

Our Parish Wedding Coordinator facilitates the wedding preparations, rehearsal and wedding ceremony. Please check in with them when you arrive at the Church for any questions or concerns.

PHOTOGRAPHERS AND PICTURE TAKING GUIDELINES:

- The photographer should be unobtrusive and discreet; please do not stop or slow down the wedding procession or enter into the sanctuary; the carpeted step area.
- Video cameras may be set up in the body of the Church, but not in the sanctuary area. Often, the open sections on the sides of church are utilized.
- If you are using our public address system for your audio recording, you
 must be certain that you are not weakening or prohibiting the operation
 of any of the microphones/speakers broadcasting sound to the
 congregation.
- Once the ceremony begins, there should no movement of any photographer; please find a place and stay there throughout the ceremony.
- We extend the time for pictures in Church for a period of 30 minutes following the wedding ceremony. Please assist the couple in organizing this time.
